Day 1 : Ciao Roma



Welcome to Rome 'The Eternal City' and the capital of Italy – the cradle of western Civilization and center of the Catholic church. Rome is truly one of the great cities of The world. Rich in history, beauty and culture, it has been an inspiration to countless Generations of visitors.Get transfer red to your conveniently located hotel. (Check-in on your own after 15:00). Overnight in Rome. (Dinner)

Day 2 : Discover ancient Rome and the Vatican City – onto Naples.



This morning, proceed for an exciting walking tour of the city of Rome – our exploration of Rome begins with a tour of the Vatican Museums – view the masterpieces collected by Popes throughout the centuries. Marvel at Michaelangelo's magnificent, frescoed ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and his famous Pieta inside the St Peter's Basilica. Pay tribute to the brave gladiators of Rome with aphotostop at the mighty Colosseum.Drive past the ruins of the Roman Forum and Piazza Venezia. Toss a coin at the Trevi fountain and make a wish to return to this ancient city! Later we proceed to Naples - regional capital of Campania and the 3rd largest city of Italy and the birthplace of Pizza! Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel. Overnight in Naples. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 3 : Blue Grotto – Isle of Capri



This morning, we will cross the Bay of Naples by ferry to the Isle of Capri–enjoy the views of the marina and venture into the island. See the Grotta Azzurra – the Blue Grotto is a sea cave on the coast of the island of Capri, southern Italy. Sunlight passing through an underwater cavity and shining through the seawater creates a blue reflection that illuminates the cavern (subject to weather permitting) Overnight in Naples. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 4 : Assisi – Wine Tour and Basilica of St Francis



This morning we continue north towards Assisi – a medieval town in central Italy's Umbria region. Assisi is recognized for its postcard-like charm, valuable art and historicbuildings.Enjoyawinetourinthisbeautifulhilltoptown.VisittheBasilicaof St Francis - famous for Giotto's exquisite frescoes and 13th century-stained glass windows. Overnight in Assisi. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 5 : Onto Pisa via Florence



This morning, we will depart for Pisa via Florence. Explore one of the world's most cultural cities today - the former home of great masters and a testament to the ambitious legacy of the Medici family. Your local guide will share all the sights, including views of the magnificent marble Duomo and Baptistery. We visit Piazza della Signoria, the heart of this flourishing city with its statues and stunning palazzi, then view the Ponte Vecchio. Tuscany lure suspast the marble quarries of Carrara to Pisa - a quiet provincial university town that is renowned for its art and culture. (Breakfast/Dinner)



Day 6 : Get mesmerized with view of Leaning Tower of Pisa – onto Venice.



This morning, we visit a remarkable group of building - in the Piazza del Duomo –the Square of Miracles This piazza contains the cathedral or Duomo the baptistery the campanile, or Leaning Tower of Pisa. Later we proceed on a journey past quant villages , medieval castles and cutting a cross the fertile Adriatic plains to the magical city of Venice. Arrive at the pier in Venice and board the boat to sail over the Giudecca Canal and pass the Adriatic Sea to arrive at St. Mark's Square. Enjoy a walking orientation tour of St. Mark's Square, which is the main square of Venice, where the only traffic is that of humans and pigeons! The famed Bell Tower and the Clock Tower, display not only the time of day but also the dominant sign of the Zodiac and the current phase of the moon. Continue to the Bridge of Sighs ,made of white lime stone that passesover the Riodi Palazzo, connecting the old prisons with interrogation rooms at the Doge's Palace.Return to the pier and later proceed to the hotel.

Overnight in Padova or similar. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 7 : Onto Verona. Enjoy a boat ride on the beautiful Lake Garda.



This morning we will travel to Verona – home of Shakespeare's star-crossed lovers. Our orientation tour will take us to Juliet's Balcony, as well as the incredible Roman arena, which is still in use today. Discover Lake Garda - largest of the Italian Lakes as we take a route along its scenic shoreline. Enjoy a boat ride on the tranquil shores and soak up the picture-perfect setting of Lake Garda. Overnight in Bergamo or Verona or similar. (Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 8 : Departure from Milan
