Day 1: Welcome to Berlin - Capital of Germany.



Welcome to Berlin – capital and largest city of Germany. Get transferred to your conveniently located hotel. (Check-in on your own after 15:00). Overnight in Berlin. (Dinner)

Day 2: Get familiar with Berlin on a guided city tour as you visit the Berlin Wall.



Embark on a guided city tour of Berlin. The city is an immaculate blend of deep history, modern flair, and multi-cultural influences. Visit "Check Point Charlie" and the remnants of the infamous Berlin Wall, which today stands as the East Side Gallery. Indulge in spectacular views of the city from the Berlin TV Tower. Drive onthe Unter den Linden, a boulevard named after the linden i.e. lime trees and arriveat the majestic Brandenburg Gate. Visit Alexanderplatz, one of the most famous squares in Berlin to observe the World time clock. Visit the imposing Reichstag. Reichstag is the seat of the German parliament and one of Berlin's most historiclandmarks. Overnight in Berlin. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 3: Onto Prague - Capital of the Czech Republic. Enjoy an orientation city tour of Dresden.



Today we drive to the Capital city of The Czech Republic – Prague. The city of a Hundred Spires, a UNESCO monument and is one of the most beautiful cities in theworld. Prague is said to be as beautiful as the city of Paris. Enroute, enjoy an orientation tour of Dresden, situated on the banks of The Elba river and dubbed as "Florence of the East". See the Semper Opera House, The Royal Courtyard of Zwinger Palace & the 18th Century Cathedral. Later continue your journey to Prague. Overnight in Prague. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 4: Enjoy a guided tour of Prague including a visit to the Prague Castle.



Proceed on a walking tour with the guide to this Fairy Tale city - Prague. Visit the remarkable Hradcany Castle, which is said to be the biggest castle in the world at about 570 meters long and about 130 meters wide. See the St. Vitus Cathedral, the seat of the Archbishop of Prague. View the magnificent Charles bridge decorated by a continuous alley of statues, in the Baroque-style. Arrive in the Old town square to witness the unique walk of the apostles at the Astronomical Clock. See Wenceslas Square - center of the business and cultural communities, and the Jewish Quarter, the smallest cadastral area of Prague. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon exploring the city on your own. Overnight in Prague. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 5: Drive to Munich - Guided city tour with BMW Museum.



Today we leave Czech Republic behind and head towards the German city of Munich. On arrival enjoy an guided tour including views of Maximilianstrasse, Königsplatz with art museums, Olympic Park, see the famed Biergartens – Beer Gardens. Take a short walk through Marienplatz and its iconic Glockenspiel. Later visit the BMW Museum to view the automation marvels. Overnight in Munich.(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)



Day 6: Onto Salzburg - Sound of Music Tour.



Today we depart for picturesque Salzburg - the city where W. A. Mozart was born and the shooting location for "The Sound of Music". The narrow lanes and broad squares of this baroque city have taken their deserved place on the UNESCO WorldHeritage List. See the Mirabell Garden and Pegasus Fountain, where Maria and thechildren danced in the movie. Learn about the historical and architectural landmarksof Salzburg as well as the Lake District. Overnight in Salzburg. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 7: Onto Vienna – Capital of Austria. Visit the famous Schonbrunn Palace.



Today we venture to Vienna – the capital city of Austria. Enjoy a visit to the BaroqueSchonbrunn Palace (subject to availability) with its tranquil gardens. Schönbrunn Palace was the main summer residence of the Habsburg rulers, located in Hietzing, Vienna. The name Schönbrunn has its roots in an artesian well from which water was consumed by the court. Overnight in Vienna.

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 8: Get familiar with the city on a guide tour of Vienna – Onto Bled - Slovenia.



See the imperial splendor of Vienna on a guided city tour. Admire the Hofburg palace, the colorful roof of St Stephen's Cathedral, the grand State Opera House, and Ringstrasse. Later we journey through the Loibl Pass to arrive in Slovenia – known for its mountains, ski resorts and lakes. Formerly a constituent republic of Yugoslavia, it is also bordered by Croatia, Hungary, and Italy. Overnight in Lake Bled or similar. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 9: Enjoy Boat ride on Lake Bled.



Today we proceed for to see the stunning beauty of Lake Bled – a Lake in the JulianAlps of the Upper Carniolan region of northwestern Slovenia, where it adjoins the town of Bled. It is also termed as the "Paradise on Earth". Enjoy an orientation tour and take a pleasurable ride in a traditional, flat-bottom wooden boat with a pointed bow and the stern widened. Overnight in Lake Bled or similar. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 10: Onto Hungary - Budapest - Paris of the East. Enjoy cruising down the riverDanube.



Drive to Hungary - a landlocked country in Central Europe. We arrive in Budapest- the majestic capital of Hungary. It is bisected by the river Danube. Enjoy a romantic cruise on the 2nd longest river in Europe. Soak in the awe-inspiring views of Budapest as you glide past. Overnight in Budapest (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 11: Guided city tour of Budapest.



Enjoy a guided city tour of Budapest, start with viewing the Fisherman's Bastion, Szechenyi Chain Bridge, and Buda Castle. Drive on the Andrassy Boulevard and arrive at the majestic Hero's Square featuring the Magyars Chieftains and diverse leaders of Hungary. View the Hungarian Parliament Building which has nearly 700rooms with its ceremonial staircase. Overnight in Budapest. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)



Day 12: Depart and fly back home.
